Fund objective



Fund manager's report

- · Asia Pacific equities advanced in August. Improving economic data, hopes of further stimulus, and progress in Covid-19 vaccines eclipsed an escalating US-China tech war.
- The earnings season was in full swing. Tencent posted better-than-expected profits thanks to higher video-games revenue, but its shares tumbled after the US banned its WeChat app. Meanwhile, Samsung Electronics also recorded good June-quarter results, due to a surge in memory chip prices.
- In portfolio activity, we subscribed to the initial public offerings of two Chinese companies. Hangzhou Tigermed is the largest clinical contract researcher in China, which carried out a secondary listing in Hong Kong. It could benefit from rising research spending on innovative drugs in the mainland, given supportive policy amid current low penetration levels. The other stock was KE Holdings, which owns property brokerage Lianjia and housing transactions platform Beike, both leading brands. We believe KE can generate powerful network effects by bringing agents onto the same platform and driving industry consolidation.
- We funded these by exiting lower-conviction holdings ASM Pacific Technology, Huazhu and Swire Properties.
