### **FUND DESCRIPTION**

The primary investment objective of the Fund is to seek high current income, consistent with prudent investment management. Long-term capital appreciation is a secondary objective. The fund aims to achieve this by employing PIMCO's best income-generating ideas across global fixed income sectors with an explicit mandate on risk-factor diversification. The fund offers daily liquidity.

The Fund may use or invest in financial derivatives.

The fund taps into multiple areas of the global bond market, and employs PIMCO's vast analytical capabilities and sector expertise to help temper the risks of high income investing. This approach seeks to provide consistent income over the long term.






