### OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

**Objectives** The objective of this Sub-Fund is to provide growth and income on the invested capital over time by achieving a return in line with the return of a portfolio of debt instruments issued by the Japanese Government represented by the benchmark.

**Benchmark** JP Morgan Japan Gov Bonds Index®. *For designing portfolio and measuring performance.*

**Investment Policy** This Sub-Fund's net assets are invested mainly in high and medium quality ("investment grade") debt and debt-related instruments issued by public authorities or private companies from any country and denominated in Japanese Yen (JPY).

In addition, the Sub-Fund is entitled to hold cash, including term deposits with credit institutions.

The duration of the portfolio will generally be comprised between 9 and 15 years.

The Sub-Fund may use derivatives financial instruments aiming at hedging risks, ensuring efficient portfolio management and/or investing according to the Investment Policy. The use of derivatives financial instruments for investment purposes may amplify the up and down fluctuations of the Sub-Fund's Net Asset Value per Unit.

This Class of Unit protects you against the fluctuations between the investment currencies and Euro.

**Strategy** In actively managing the fund, the investment manager uses a limited tracking error (LTE) approach, which involves investing similarly to a benchmark while intentionally over- or underweighting certain securities as a way of seeking to add to the fund's performance. Quantitative deviation limitations underlying the investment approach will restrict the extent to which the performance of the fund may deviate from the benchmark. The fund's exposure to securities, and thus its performance, are likely to closely resemble those of the benchmark.

**Redemption** You may sell your units on demand at any time. The redemption orders are executed on the basis of the Net Asset Value per Unit of the day when the request is received in Luxembourg before the dealing deadline. The Net Asset Value per Unit is calculated daily.

**Distribution Policy** This Unit Class is not distributing dividends. Income from investments is reinvested.

This Class of Unit is placed in the category 3 based on a simulated historical performance over the last five years.

This category reflects the exposure of the Sub-Fund to JPY-denominated fixed income instruments mainly issued by investment grade governments, associated with a currency risk hedging activity between EUR and investment currencies at Class of Unit level.

Other materially relevant risks for this Sub-Fund that are not adequately captured in this synthetic indicator:

- counterparty risk: risk that a third-party with which the Sub-Fund entered into contracts in order to perform some operations may default on its obligations.
- credit risk: risk that the issuer of debt instruments fails to pay to the Sub-Fund interests and principal, even only in part.

The charges you pay are used to pay the costs of running the Sub-Fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing it. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.

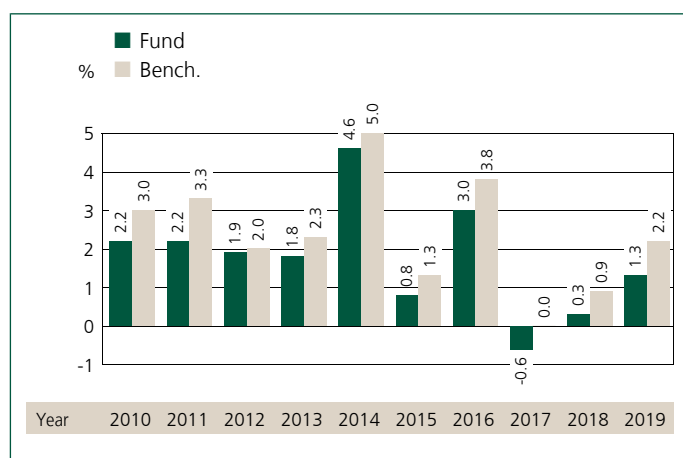

- The ongoing charges figure (of which management fees 0.20%) is based on the last year's expenses, for the year ending December 2019. It excludes portfolio transaction costs, except in the case of entry/exit charges paid by the Sub-Fund when buying or selling units in another collective investment undertaking. This figure may vary from year to year.
- The ongoing charges figure excludes also securities lending revenue sharing agreement with the securities lending agent (that receives 30% of the revenues generated by the activity), as this does not increase the costs of running the Sub-Fund.
