

The MSCI ACM/I Growth is a free float-adjusted market capitalization.

The MSCI ACWI Growth is a free float-adjusted market capitalization weighted index that is designed to measure the growth equity market performance of developed and emerging markets. The MSCI World Index is a market capitalisation weighted index representative of the market structure of developed market countries in North Armerica, Europe, and the Asia/Pacific region.

Debt/capital ratio is a measure of a company's financial leverage, calculated as the company's debt divided by its total capital. PEG ratio is a stock's price/earnings ratio divided by estimated earnings growth rate in the next year; a lower PEG indicates that less is being paid for each unit of earnings growth. Price/earnings ratio is the current stock price over trailing 12-month earnings per share. ROIC (return on invested capital) measures how effectively a company uses the money invested in its operations, calculated as a company's net income minus any dividends divided by the company's total capital. The higher the ratio, the better the

portfolio's risk-adjusted return is.

Excess Returns are the performance returns of a portfolio that is in excess of an index or benchmark. Sharpe Ratio is a calculation that reflects the reward per each unit of risk in a portfolio. The higher the ratio, the better the portfolio's risk-adjusted return is.

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
