## Objective and Investment Policy

### Investment Objective

The Sub-Fund seeks to generate income, measured in USD, from a broad-based portfolio of global equity securities.

### Investment Policy

The Sub-Fund will seek to achieve the objectives of the Sub-Fund by investing at all times its total net assets in global equities and equities-related instruments issued by companies which in the investment manager's opinion, have the highest level of risk adjusted dividend yield.

The Investment Manager will use proprietary models to find such equities and use a systematic investment process to build diversified and risk-controlled portfolio.

There is no predetermined geographical asset allocation and the Sub-Fund may invest its net assets in either developed or emerging markets.

The Sub-Fund may invest up to one third of its net assets in Money Market Instruments.

Within a limit of 200% of the Sub-Fund's net assets, the investment strategy may be achieved by direct investments and/or through derivatives. Derivatives may also be used for hedging purposes.

### Income

For Capitalisation share classes (Cap), the dividend is reinvested.

### Sub-Fund Currency

The reference currency of the Sub-Fund is USD.

### Investment Horizon

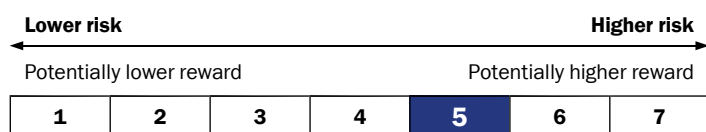
This Sub-Fund may not be suitable for investors who plan to withdraw their contribution within 8 years.

### Processing of subscription and redemption orders

The subscription, conversion or redemption orders must be received by the Registrar and Transfer Agent on any Valuation Day no later than 3 p.m. Luxembourg time. Orders will be processed at the Net Asset Value applicable to the following Valuation Day. The investor's attention is drawn to the existence of potential additional processing time due to the possible involvement of intermediaries such as Financial Advisers or distributors.

The Net Asset Value of this Sub-Fund is calculated on a daily basis.

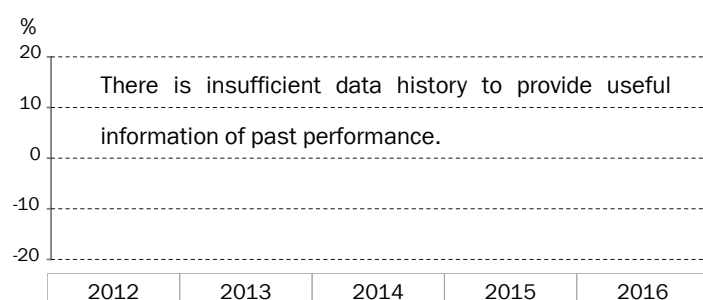
