Opportunities

Information ratio: the information ratio expresses the ratio of additional returns generated to the extra risk involved. The value generated can be used to evaluate active management.

Modified duration: a risk indicator that measures the effect of price fluctuations on a bond issue or a portfolio of bond issues.

Residual maturity: time remaining until a bond must be repaid.

Sharpe ratio: the Sharpe ratio (risk-adjusted performance) is generated by calculating the difference between the average annualised return and the risk-free Total Expense Ratio (TER): the TER is a measure of the total annual expenses incurred by a fund and is expensed as a percentage. It allows an accurate comparison of the costs of funds from different companies to be made.

Tracking error: the tracking error measures the divergence between the return of a fund in relation to its benchmark

Volatility: a risk indicator demonstrating the fluctuation range (for example of the price or return of a security or fund unit) over a defined period; volatility is most often calculated using standard deviation. The higher the volatility, the greater the fluctuation range.

Yield to maturity: the yield to maturity is the average yield generated by an investment each year if it is held until expiry.

Yield to worst: the lowest potential rate of return an investor could receive on investment in a callable bond, assuming the bond does not go into default.
