Objectives & Investment Policy

The aim is to provide you with a return in line with the returns earned on the money markets, while preserving the value of your investment.

The Fund is actively managed and mainly invests in high quality Euro denominated short term tradable debt (known as bonds) and money market instruments (a range of short-term financial products which can be easily bought and sold on money markets) with an average outstanding repayment term of not more than 12 months and carrying one of the two highest short term ratings from the major rating agencies.

To a lesser degree the Fund may invests in cash, deposit accounts with certain holding periods (known as time deposits) or


money market instruments with short repayment terms. To ensure the return is in line with the returns on short term debt markets, the Fund primarily purchases debt with interest rates which either match those on short term debt markets or which can be reset, prior to maturity, to match interest rates on short term debt markets.

The Fund may use financial contracts (derivatives) to manage risk, reduce costs or improve results.

Income is not paid out and is rolled up (accumulated) into the value of your investment.

You may sell your investment on a daily basis.

Risk and Reward Profile



The risk and reward category is calculated using historical data which may not be a reliable indicator of the Fund's future risk profile.

As a money market fund, investors may choose to invest in the Fund as an alternative to investing in a regular deposit account but should be aware of the risks associated with investing in funds, in particular that the value of your investment will fluctuate as the net asset value of the Fund fluctuates.

The Fund is not guaranteed and your investment is at risk. You may lose some or all of your investment. Future legal or regulatory change could have a substantial adverse effect on the fund and your investment.


The entry and exit charges shown are maximum figures. In some cases you might pay less - you can find this out from your financial adviser or distributor.
