Objective and Investment Policy

Objective: The Fund's objective is to seek long-term capital, income and currency appreciation.

Policy: The Fund will primarily invest in fixed or floating debt securities such as notes, bills, bonds, commercial paper, certificates of deposit and floating rate notes issued primarily by governments or corporate borrowers in the Asia Region, Australia and New Zealand and will be principally listed on Recognised Markets in the Asia Region or international financial markets with a credit rating of BBB– and above as rated by Standard & Poor's or an equivalent credit rating as determined by the Investment Manager, but up to 20% of the Fund's net assets may be invested in lower quality securities.

The Fund may use techniques and instruments for the purposes of efficient portfolio management with a level of risk which is consistent with the risk profile of the Fund, such as forward foreign currency exchange contracts, futures contracts, options, put and call options on securities, indices and currencies, swap contracts, repurchase/reverse repurchase agreements and/or stocklending agreements. The use of these instruments may result in the Fund being leveraged. However, the total exposure of the Fund as a result of all positions held by it will not exceed its Net Asset Value. The Investment Manager has discretion in managing the investments of the Fund.

Distributions on income share classes will be paid bi-annually. Portfolio transaction costs may have an impact on the performance of the Fund and are paid out of the assets of the Fund in addition to the charges detailed below.


Benchmark: The Fund will utilise a benchmark index comprised of 50% Markit iBoxx ADBI™ ("ADBI") and 50% Markit iBoxx ALBI™ ("ALBI") for comparison purposes only.

Profile of typical investor: The Fund is suitable for investors seeking capital growth and income over a 5- to 10-year time horizon with a medium level of volatility.

Dealing: Shares in the Fund can be bought and sold daily (every Business Day of the Fund).


Performance fee
