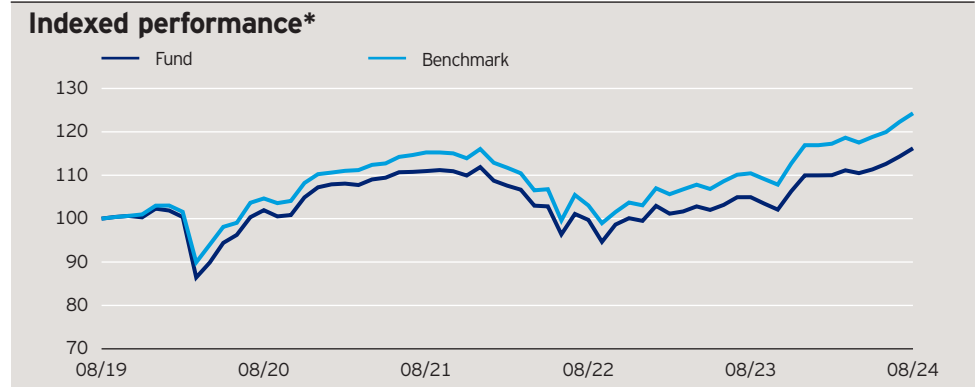
## Investment risks

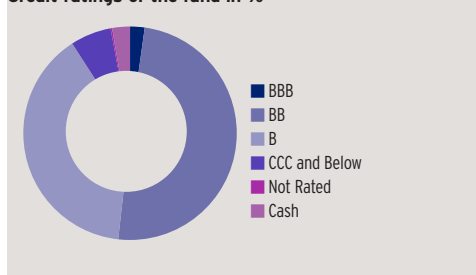
