Objectives and Investment Policy

The Fund seeks primarily to provide regular income in the form of dividend and, to a lesser extent, to generate capital growth by investing directly on all types of asset classes in these limits (government bonds: 0%-100%, money market instrument: 0%-100%, equities: 0%-60%, cash: 0%-49%, high yield bonds: 0%-40%, real estate securities: 0%-40%, investment grade bonds: 0%-40%, emerging market debt: 0%-30%, convertible bonds: 0%-20%, floating rate securities: 0%-20%, structured debt securities: 0%-20%, commodities: 0%-10%).

In respect of the above investments limits, the sub-funds investments into China A-Shares via the Stock Connect may reach up to 25% of its assets.

The investment team will determine the asset class mix based on its medium and short terms views on the economic cycle and also the sustainability of the dividends.

Income are systematically reinvested.

Investors are able to redeem on a daily basis (on Luxembourg bank business days).

- Why is the Fund in this specific category? The risk category is justified by the investment in different asset classes with a standard asset mix that is a good balance between risky assets and less risky assets.
- The higher the risk, the longer the recommended investment horizon.

Other risks materially relevant to the Fund which are not adequately captured by the indicator are described below:

- <u>Credit Risk:</u> This risk relates to the ability of an issuer to honour its commitments: downgrades of an issue or issuer rating may lead to a drop in the value of associated bonds.
- Liquidity Risk: This risk arises from the difficulty of selling an asset at a fair market price and at a desired time due to lack of buyers.
- <u>Counterparty Risk</u>: This risk is associated with the ability of a counterparty in an Over The Counter financial transaction to fulfil its commitments like payment, delivery and reimbursement.
- **Operational and Custody Risk:** Some markets are less regulated than most of the international markets; hence, the services related to custody and liquidation for the subfund on such markets could be more risky.
- **Derivatives Risk**: When investing in over the counter or listed derivatives, the Fund aims to hedge and/or to leverage the yield of its position. The attention of the investor is drawn to the fact that leverage increases the volatility of the subfund.
- <u>Risks related to Shanghai Hong Kong Stock Connect:</u> This risk relates to securities trading and clearing through the Stock Connect.Stock Connect is subject to quota limitation which may restrict the fund's ability to invest in China A-Shares on a timely basis. In addition, the Stock Connect is novel in nature, the regulations are untested and there is no certainty as to how they will be applied, which may affect the fund's ability to enforce its rights and interests in the China A-Shares.




