Objectives and Investment Policy

- Aims to maximise return through capital appreciation and income.
- At least 70% invested in a broad range of bonds of issuers globally. Has an active asset allocation approach, which may include investment into high yield and emerging markets bonds. Investments will not be required to meet minimum rating standards.
- A minimum of 70% of the fund's net assets will be invested in securities that maintain sustainable characteristics. Sustainable characteristics may include,but are not limited to, effective governance and superior management of environmental and social issues ('ESG').
- The fund is not subject to any limitation on the portion of its Net Assets Value that may invest in high yield securities or issuers.
- Less than 30% of the fund's assets will be invested in Hybrids and contingent convertible bonds, with less than 20% of the total net assets to be invested in contingent convertible bonds.
- The fund may invest its net assets directly in onshore China bonds listed or traded on any eligible market in China.
- Has the freedom to invest outside the fund's principal geographies, market sectors, industries or asset classes.
- Investments may be made in bonds issued in currencies other than the fund's reference currency. Exposure to currencies may be hedged, for example with currency forward contracts. The reference currency is the currency used for reporting and may be different from the dealing currency.
- Can invest in bonds issued by governments, companies and other bodies.
- May invest in units of other investment funds.
- May invest in assets directly or achieve exposure indirectly through other eligible means including derivatives. Can use derivatives with the aim of risk or cost reduction or to generate additional capital or income, including for investment purposes, in line with the fund's risk profile.
- The fund has discretion in its choices of investments within its objectives and policies.
- Income is accumulated in the share price.
- Shares can usually be bought and sold each business day of the fund.
- With effect from 18 December 2019, this share class will be closed.

Risk and Reward Profile

- The fund may invest in instruments denominated in currencies other than the fund base currency. Changes in currency exchange rates can therefore affect the value of your investment.

- The use of derivatives may result in "leverage" by which we mean a level of exposure which could expose the fund to the potential of greater gains or losses than would otherwise be the case.
- There is a risk that the issuers of bonds may not be able to repay the money they have borrowed or make interest payments. While we seek to mitigate this, the fund may be exposed to the risk of financial loss if it invests into an instrument issued by an entity that subsequently defaults on its borrowings. Losses may also be realised if an entity that the fund is exposed to ceases to make interest payments over a period of time or indefinitely. Bond prices have an inverse relationship with interest rates such that when interest rates rise, bonds may fall in value. Rising interest rates may cause the value of your investment to fall.


