Fund description

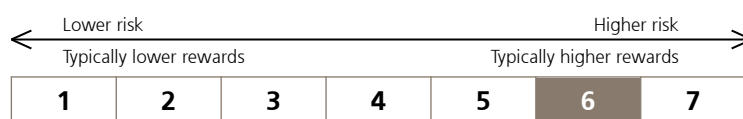
- This actively managed equity fund invests in European companies of all capitalizations that offer a high dividend yield.

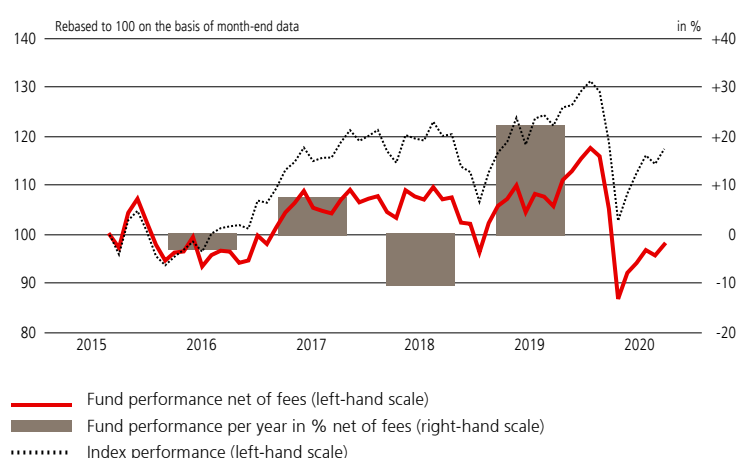
