Investment Strategy

Alma Platinum MidOcean Absolute Return Credit (the "Fund") is an open-ended UCITS compliant fund that employs a long/short corporate credit approach focusing on US companies. The Investment Manager of the Fund is MidOcean Credit Fund Management, L.P. ("MidOcean"). The Investment Manager follows the MidOcean Absolute Return Credit strategy (the "Strategy"). The Strategy primarily invests in liquid short-dated corporate bonds, with a core focus on callable securities and credit default swaps. The combination of relative value positions with outright long or short credit holdings will typically produce a low duration and diversified portfolio. The Strategy utilizes fundamental analysis to seek alpha opportunities primarily in short duration callable bonds. The Investment Manager typically constructs the portfolio with a net long bias and will seek to dynamically adjust the Sub-Fund's net credit exposure and market exposure to optimise the portfolio's risk profile given then prevailing market conditions. The gross leverage is not expected to exceed 750% of the value of the Fund. The fund is classified under article 8 of the European Regulation on sustainability related disclosures in the financial services sector (SFDR).

Commentary - MidOcean Credit Partners - November (2)

The UCITS (share class: DMAI1CU, the "Fund") generated an estimated net return of -0.71% in November. Consistent with prior periods, the Fund experienced a shallower draw down versus the broader market due to the conservative positioning of the long book, coupled with a mix of index and single-name shorts. Gross performance in the month was led by gains in the short book versus the losses in the long book. As we would expect during periods of volatility, the detraction in the long book was mitigated by a strong coupon return which helped soften the negative mark-to-market. The Fund was well positioned for the volatility in 4Q21 as it had been running with lower-than-average long exposures through 2021. As credit markets began to sell-off in November, we took advantage of the volatility to source both new and existing positions that had entered our target yield profile and were either currently callable or about to enter their first call period. We also crystalized some of the gains in the short book throughout the month. As a result of these actions in the month of November, the Fund's long book increased while the Fund's short book reduced slightly, resulting in a meaningfully higher net exposure compared to the prior month.

The most meaningful contributions stemmed from two index hedge positions which benefited from the broader market sell-off and two single-name alpha shorts, a quick-serve restaurant franchisee and an extreme value retailer/grocer. Our position in a Massachusetts-based REIT that owns a mix of hotels and net leased properties across the US and Canada, was the largest detractor as Omicron variant headlines had negative impacts on price. Going forward, the increased net exposure and corresponding increase to running coupon will position the Fund well for 2022 where we believe coupon will be the leading driver of returns across the HY asset class.
