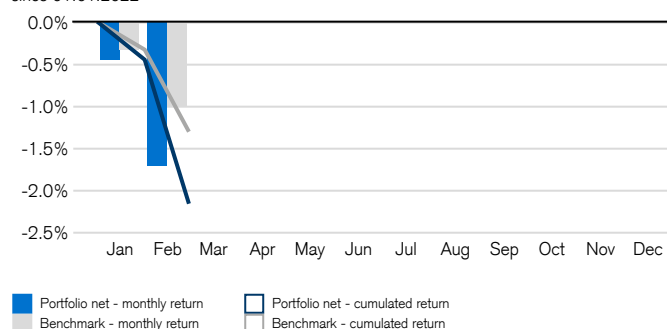

The fund may use derivative instruments in order to reduce the interest-risk of debt instruments with a longer maturity, targeting duration between 0 and 3 years.

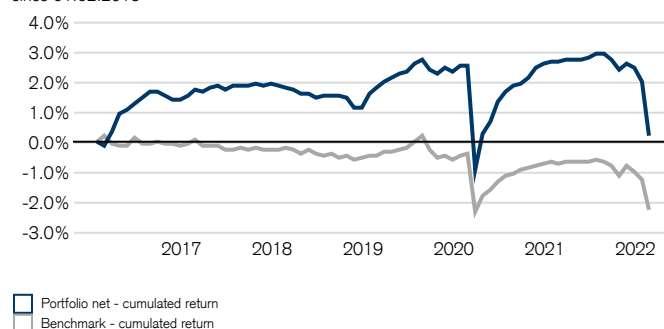
## Performance overview\* - monthly & cumulated

## Potential Risks

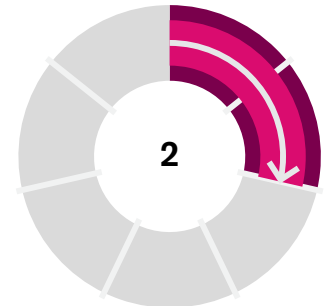

- Credit risk: Issuers of assets held by the Fund may not pay income or repay capital when due. Part of the Fund's investments may have considerable credit risk.
