The Fund is managed by Generali Investments Luxembourg S.A.

Objectives and Investment Policy

The Fund seeks to pay out sustainable annual distributions over 5 years and to preserve capital at the Fund's maturity date being 9 April 2021 (the "Maturity Date").

The Fund will exclusively invest in debt securities only denominated in Euro or in USD and in both Developed and Emerging Markets debt securities. The percentage of Emerging Markets debt securities will not exceed 20% of all debt securities. The percentage of non-investment grade debt securities will not exceed 60% of all the debt securities. The Fund will not invest in debts securities rated lower than CCC+, in accordance with S&P rating or Moody's equivalent.

The percentage of debt securities rated CCC+ will not exceed 15% of all debt securities.

The Fund may invest up to 10% of its net assets in non-Euro denominated interest-bearing debt securities on an unhedged (currency) basis.

The Fund may use financial derivatives instruments such as Credit Default Swaps (CDS) for the purpose of hedging and efficient portfolio management and also investment purposes.

During the first 4 years, the Fund will distribute an annual dividend of minimum 2.2 Euro per Unit. During the final year before the Maturity Date, the Sub-Fund may pay an annual or an interim dividend up to 100% of the investment income gains and realized capital gains.

At Maturity Date, the Fund will cease to exist and will be liquidated.

The Fund is open-ended Fund. You might redeem units of the Fund on any Valuation Day.

The Unit Class makes dividend payment.

The Fund has no reference benchmark.

Risk and Reward Profile

Significant risk(s) for the Fund not taken into account in this indicator include the following:

Credit Risk: The Fund invests a substantial portion of its assets in bonds. The issuers may become insolvent, whereby the bonds may lose a major part of their value or their value entirely.

Liquidity Risk: Risk related to a limited market activity that could not allow the Fund to sell or buy underlying investments in suitable conditions.

Counterparty Risk: The Fund primarily concludes derivatives trades with various contracting parties. There is a risk that counterparties may no longer be able to honour their payment or settlement obligations.

Operational Risk and Depositary Risk: The Fund may fall victim to fraud or other criminal acts. It may also incur losses due to misunderstandings or errors by employees of the management company, the depositary or external third parties. Finally, its' management or the custody of its' assets can be adversely affected by external events such as fires, natural disasters etc.

Capital erosion risk: The Fund takes its dividends from the income of the Fund in the first instance. In the event there is insufficient income, dividends may be paid from the capital of the Fund, it will result in capital erosion and may constrain further capital growth.

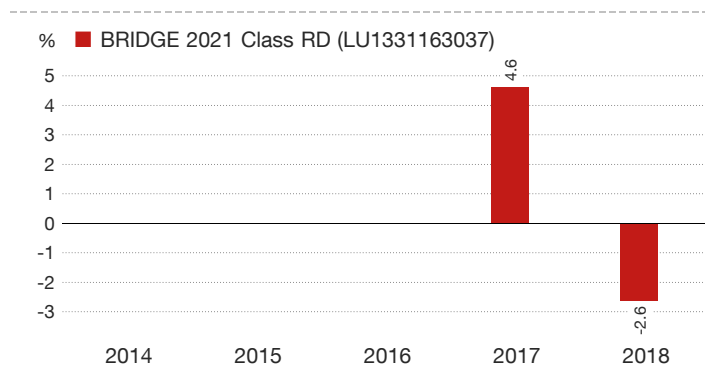
There is no conversion commission applied.
