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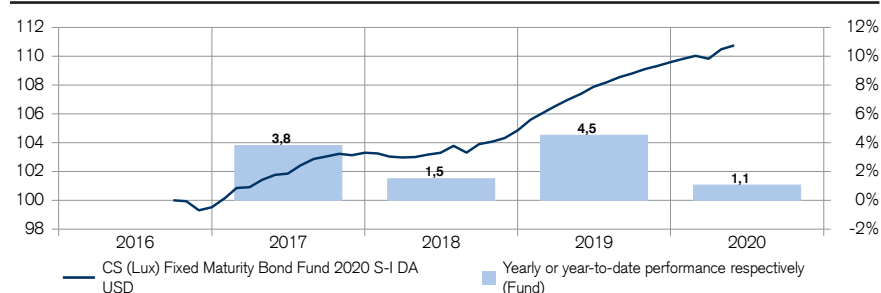

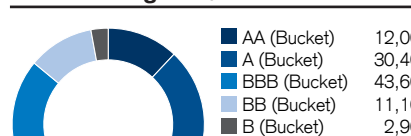
Net performance in USD (rebased to 100) and yearly performance ²⁾

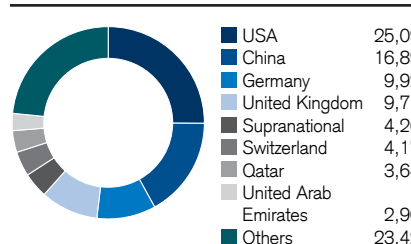

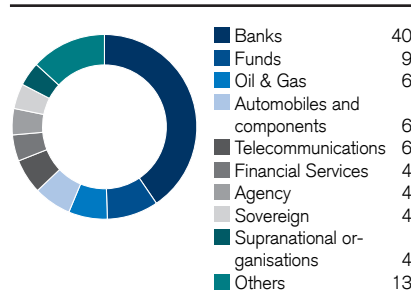

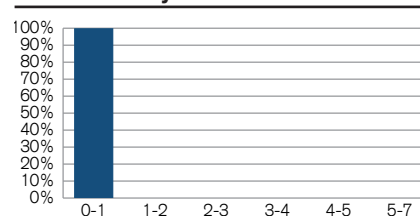
Countries in %



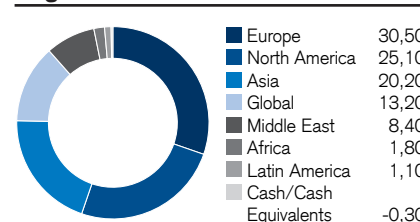
Sectors in %

Potential risks
