R4 Activa Andante (the "Sub-Fund") is a sub-fund of Renta 4 (the "Fund") Class R EUR (the "Class") - ISIN: LU1545927417

The Fund has appointed Renta 4 Luxembourg as management company.

Objectives and investment policy

The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to offer its shareholders the possibility to invest in a diversified portfolio of shares or units of investment funds.

Underlying Funds in which the Sub-Fund invests are managed with an active asset allocation policy.

Investment in units or shares of Underlying Funds and the allocation among different asset classes will depend on market conditions and opportunities for portfolio diversification.

The selection of Underlying Funds will be determined by the investment manager based on their historical behaviour as well as volatility and qualitative evaluation criteria.

qualitative evaluation criteria.

The Sub-Fund may, through Underlying Funds, be exposed to up to 100% of its assets to equities traded in the Eurozone and / or in international markets.

The Sub-Fund may also, through Underlying Funds, be exposed to debt securities whose rating is below investment grade and to emerging market debt securities.

In addition, the Sub-Fund may be exposed, through Underlying Funds, to up to 10% of its assets to commodities through UCITS eligible assets. The Sub-Fund can invest directly up to 50% of its assets in equities and debt instruments described above.

The Sub-Fund may use derivatives traded or not on regulated derivative markets for both to optimise portfolio management and to protect its

value against adverse movements on the financial markets.

Dealing Frequency

The net asset value for the Class is calculated on each bank business day in Luxembourg based on the pricing of the preceding bank business day ("the Transaction Day"). The cut-off time to submit subscriptions and/or redemptions orders is 4 p.m. Luxembourg time on the Transaction Day.

Distribution Policy

The Class is cumulative. No dividend will normally be distributed.

Currency

The currency of the Class is EUR.

Minimum investment and/or holding requirement

The minimum subscription amount is EUR 1'000 for the initial subscription and the minimum subsequent subscription amount is EUR 100.

This Class is reserved to retail and private banking investors.

Why is this Sub-Fund in this category?

The indicator measures the risk of price fluctuations in the Sub-Fund shares based on the last 5 years volatility and places the Sub-Fund in category 5. This means that the purchase of shares of the Sub-Fund exposes to a upper medium risk level, with exposure to both variable income securities and emerging markets.

Are there any other particular Risks?

Risks that could affect fund performance and are not necessarily fully reflected in the risk and reward indicator include:

- Liquidity risks: The Sub-Fund may invest part of its assets in less liquid securities. Those are securities that cannot easily be sold or exchanged for cash without a substantial loss in value in certain market conditions. Those securities also cannot be sold quickly because of a lack of ready and willing investors or speculators to purchase the asset.
- Counterparty risks: The Sub-Fund can conclude various transactions with contractual partners. If a contractual partner becomes insolvent, it can no longer or can only partly settle unpaid debts owed to the Sub-Fund.
- Credit risks: The Sub-Fund may invest a portion of its assets in debt securities. The issuers of these debt securities may become insolvent, which will mean that the securities will lose all or some of their value.

 Risks from the use of derivatives: The Sub-Fund may use financial derivatives instruments which may result in the sub-fund being leveraged and may result in material fluctuations in the value of the Sub-Fund. Leverage on certain types of transactions including derivatives may impair the Sub-Fund's liquidity, cause it to liquidate positions at unfavourable times or otherwise cause the Sub-Fund not to achieve its intended objective.

Leverage occurs when the economic exposure created by the use of derivatives is greater than the amount invested resulting in the Sub-Fund being exposed to a greater loss than the initial investment.

 Operational risks: The Sub-Fund may fall victim to fraud or criminal acts. It may suffer losses as a result of misunderstandings or mistakes by employees of the Management Company or by external third parties or may be damaged by external events, such as natural disasters.

Performance fee
