Objectives and Investment Policy
The Fund belongs to the category of funds of funds. It seeks to increase the value of its assets over the medium term by investing through funds in all types of asset classes. In a scenario of upwardly moving markets the Fund will be managed against the neutral allocation (47% equities, 37% debt instruments and 16% alternative investments (see full prospectus definition)). The manager can vary the actual asset class weightings based on market conditions and forecasts within the following range (Equities: 25%-65%, Debt Securities: 15%-55%, Alternative Investments: 0%-35%, Money Market Instruments: 0%-60%). In a scenario of downward moving financial markets the Fund will protect itself by investing part of its assets in money market instruments and debt securities with an average maturity of less than 12 months, denominated in Euro. However, when such investment is not considered appropriate, the Fund may invest directly in underlying assets.
It is actively managed and as such may invest in securities that are not included in an internal index of which the underlying sectors are weighted as follows: 47% EQUITY + 37% BOND + 16% OTHER.
A dividend may be distributed.
Investors are able to redeem on a daily basis (on Luxembourg bank business days).

- Why is the Fund in this specific category?
The risk category is justified by the investment in different asset classes with a standard asset mix that is a good balance between risky assets and less risky assets.

Other risks materially relevant to the Fund which are not adequately captured by the indicator are described below:

- Credit Risk:** This risk relates to the ability of an issuer to honour its commitments: downgrades of an issue or issuer rating may lead to a drop in the value of associated bonds.
- Liquidity Risk:** This risk arises from the difficulty of selling an asset at a fair market price and at a desired time due to lack of buyers.

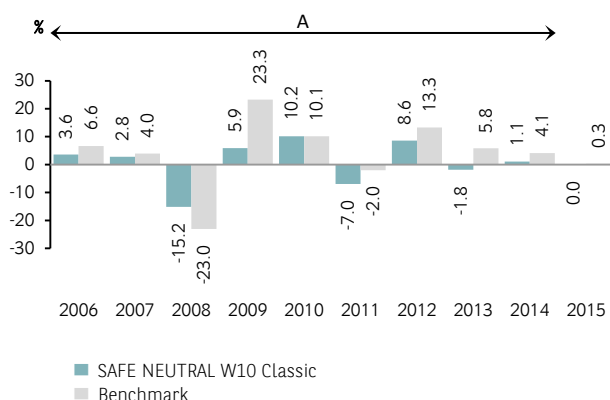
This figure may vary from year to year. It excludes:
