Objectives and Investment Policy

The objective of the Fund is to provide long-term capital appreciation and to outperform its Benchmark.

The Fund shall essentially invest in equities and other participation rights of companies incorporated or having their registered office in Central and Eastern Europe, listed on the stock exchanges of Central and Eastern Europe Countries (CEEC).

The Fund may also invest on an ancillary basis in equities, in participation rights and in equity-linked securities of European issuers.

The Fund is actively managed and references the Benchmark by seeking to outperform it. The Investment Manager has full discretion over the composition of the Fund's portfolio and there are no restrictions on the extent to which the Fund's portfolio and performance may deviate from the ones of the Benchmark.

Liquidity Risk: Risk related to a limited market activity that could not allow the Fund to sell or buy underlying investments in suitable conditions.


