The geographic asset allocation of the Fund will be based on the Manager's then prevailing policy and stock selection will be carried out on a regional basis.

He joined Henderson from Morgan Stanley, where he managed concentrated and diversified global equity portfolios for both institutional and retail investors. Prior to this, Wouter worked at ABN AMRO Asset Management as a global equity portfolio manager. Wouter holds a master degree in economics from the University of Leuven (Belgium), studied at London Business School and is a CFA charterholder. Ian Tabberer joined Henderson in 2015 as an Investment Manager in the Global Equities team. Prior to joining Henderson, Ian was an Investment Manager at Baillie Gifford where he was a key member of a number of highly successful Global and North American equity products, covering both holistic and segregated approaches to Global portfolio construction. Before that, Ian was a US Investment Director at Scottish Widows. Ian started his career in asset management as a US Equity Analyst and Portfolio Manager at EFM after spending 10 years as a Royal Naval Warfare Officer.Ian has a BSc (Hons) in Geography from Southampton University and is a CFA charterholder.
