1. FUND INFORMATION

Description

Investment objective

The Lyxor SG Global Quality Income NTR UCITS ETF - Acc is a UCITS compliant exchange traded fund that aims to track the benchmark index SG Global Quality Income NTR.

The SG Global Quality Income NTR tracks companies with attractive and sustainable dividends recognizing that in the long run, dividends have dominated equity returns while higher risk has not provided higher rewards. In that respect, the index methodology defines an investment universe of non financial companies having a free float adjusted market capitalisation of at least US\$ 3bn from developed countries

Risk Factors


