The Fund is an Authorised Unit Trust established as a non-UCITS retail scheme ('NURS'). ISIN GB0032033127. This fund is managed by Hargreaves Lansdown Fund Managers (HLFM), part of Hargreaves Lansdown PLC.

This fund is authorised in the United Kingdom and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority (FCA).

OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

The investment objective of the Fund is to provide income and capital growth.

The Fund will invest principally in collective investment schemes, generally established in Europe (including the UK, Jersey and Guernsey), the underlying investments of which are equity and floating and fixed interest securities. The Fund will principally invest in UK equity income funds, but it may also have exposure to smaller companies and overseas markets.

The Fund is benchmarked against the IA Equity Income Sector and will maintain a minimum 80% equity exposure with the intention of achieving a historic yield on the distributable income in excess of 100% of the FTSE All Share yield at the Fund's year end on a 3-year rolling basis (and not less than 90% on an annual basis).


The Fund may use derivative instruments and forward transactions for the limited purposes of efficient portfolio management, including hedging.

Dividend income generated by the Fund is reinvested.

You can normally buy or sell units in this Fund on each Business Day. Instructions received and accepted up until 11.00am will be dealt at the price calculated at 11.00am that day.

Recommendation: this fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.


