FUND COMMENTARY

We stand at a striking juncture in US economic and corporate history. The second quarter delivered a record GDP fall of -9.5% (-32.9% annualised). Intuitively, this should lead to the worst corporate earnings season on record. We are almost two-thirds the way through the reporting season for the S&P 500 constituents and have interesting results thus far.

Apart from absolute results, clearly investor perceptions of those results are paramount. In this context, two-thirds of the companies have reported a contraction in Sales, in total down -12%*. Whilst this result is positively skewed by large Technology related businesses with strong results, on the surface it seems not too severe given the extremely low level of economic activity. Then, critically, in terms of investor expectations, the Sales number is 2% better than consensus expectations and the related Earnings number is 22% better than expectations. Two-thirds of the companies beat Sales expectations and 85% of all companies beat Earnings expectations. It, therefore, seems that investors generally have received positive surprises through the reporting season thus far.

Investor expectations were, of course, slashed as most economies were locked down. Expectations for twelve month forward Earnings for the S&P 500 constituents reached a bottom in the middle of May, a drop of -22% from its peak level. These expectations have since been revised upwards by +6%. Whilst it has a long way to go to recover to its peak, the direction of travel is supportive for overall investor sentiment.

We do not know yet whether the US economic recovery will be in a V, U, W or L shape, but we put a low probability to the latter. Then, irrespective of the shape of the eventual economic recovery, at this very early phase of the recovery process while still being in a recession, historically the S&P 500 has followed the same positive recovery pattern for over six months.
