Objectives and investment policy

To match as closely as possible the performance of the FTSE 100 Index (the "Index") by investing in UK shares. The Fund aims to perform in line with the Index before deduction of fees.

The Fund aims to invest in shares of all of the companies within the Index. This is often referred to as a 'full replication' approach.

Where HBOS Investment Fund Managers Limited (HIFML) believes it can provide an advantage to the Fund in managing costs, to achieve a more efficient way of tracking the Index, or where there are exceptional market circumstances, the Fund may include or exclude specific shares and/or other security types which are representative of a share in the Index (such as depositary receipts).

The Fund may also invest in collective investment schemes to gain exposure to the Index.

Derivatives and stock lending may be used for the purpose of managing the Fund in a way that is designed to reduce risk or cost and/or generate extra income or growth (often referred to as efficient portfolio management).

The FTSE 100 Index provides a representation of the returns of securities in the UK equity market.

The Index measures the performance of shares of the 100 largest companies listed in the UK.

Note: the Fund will underperform the Index after deduction of fees.


Investors should aim to hold their investment in the Fund for the medium to long term (at least five to ten years).

Any Income received by the Fund is retained in the Fund and has the effect of increasing the share price.

Shares can usually be bought and sold on any working day.

Risk and reward profile

The Risk and Reward Indicator table demonstrates where the Fund ranks in terms of its potential risk and reward. The higher the rank the greater the potential reward but the greater the risk of losing money. It is based on past data, may change over time and may not be a reliable indication of the future risk profile of the Fund. The shaded area in the table below shows the Fund's ranking on the Risk and Reward Indicator.



- The Fund is ranked at 5 because it has experienced medium to high levels of volatility over the past 5 years.


