Its objective is to achieve capital growth over the long-term by following its investment policy and strategy.

Sustainability approach

The Fund aims for long-term growth by investing in companies that contribute to, and benefit from, sustainable development. We believe this leads to positive social and environmental outcomes. Every company we invest in helps improve human development, and many also have positive environmental impacts. We evaluate the Fund's contributions to social and environmental outcomes using the two frameworks described below.

Positive social outcomes - human development pillars We consider the following four broad <u>human development</u> categories to assess how each company in the Fund contributes to positive social outcomes:



Health and well-being - improved access to affordable nutrition, healthcare and hygiene, water and sanitation



Physical infrastructure - improved access to affordable energy and housing



Economic welfare - safe employment offering a living wage and opportunities for advancement, access to finance and improved standards of living



Opportunity and empowerment - improved access to affordable education and information technology

Positive environmental outcomes - Project Drawdown climate solutions

Project Drawdown is a non-profit organisation that has mapped and measured over 90 different and existing climate solutions. These are existing practices and technologies, such as renewable energy and recycling. We use these to assess whether companies in the Fund contribute to positive environmental outcomes. The solutions can be summarised into the following eight broad categories:



Portfolio Explorer

Our <u>Portfolio Explorer</u> tool provides the contribution that each investee company makes to climate solutions and human development. It also shows what we like about each company, the most relevant Sustainable Development Goals, key risks, and areas for improvement. We update the holdings on Portfolio Explorer every quarter.

Engagement and voting

No company is perfect, so Stewart Investors sees engagement and voting as key duties as long-term investors. We believe engagement helps reduce risk, tackle social and environmental issues, and improve sustainability. It is a core part of the investment team's responsibilities and gives us valuable insights into each company.

Exposure to harmful or controversial products, services or practices

We use international standards such as the United Nations global norms to assess the Fund for <u>harmful or</u> <u>controversial products</u>, <u>services or practices</u> and exposure to high-risk sectors e.g. fossil fuels. We do this at least once every quarter.

We will not invest in any companies that make revenue from tobacco production and controversial weapons. We will not invest in companies which make more than 5% of their revenue from harmful products and services. We use internal analysis and external research to assess company activities such as employee or supply chain issues which cannot be measured by revenue.

If we have invested in a company that is above any of these limits, we will disclose this on our website and explain why we continue to own this company.

Sustainability metrics

As at 30 June 2024 the Fund held 35 companies.

Positive social outcomes

All companies (100%) were contributing to at least one human development pillar and, in total, were making 98 contributions to the pillars.

Positive environmental outcomes

22 companies (63%) were contributing to climate change solutions. These companies were contributing to
37 different solutions and, in total, were making 78 contributions to the solutions.
