The fund aims to provide capital growth in excess of the Russell 2000 Lagged (Net Total Return) Index, after fees have been deducted over a three to five year period by investing in equities of small-sized US companies.

This fund may use financial derivative instruments as a part of the investment process. Derivatives carry a high degree of risk and should only be considered by sophisticated investors.

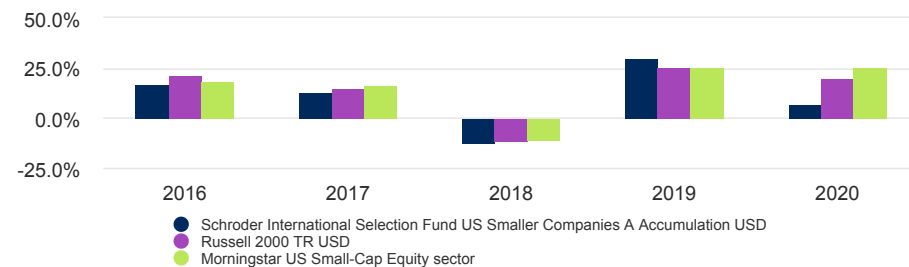

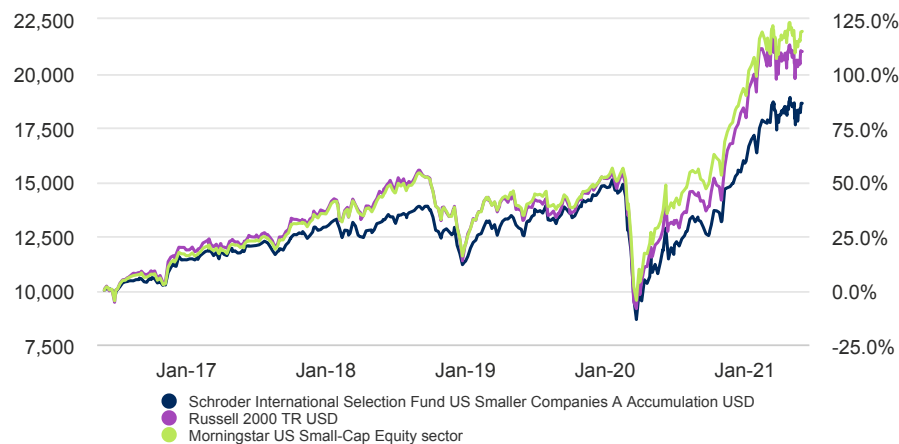

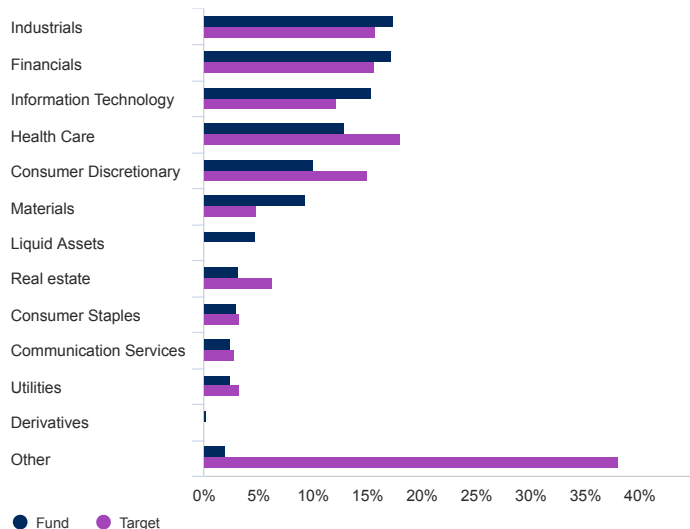

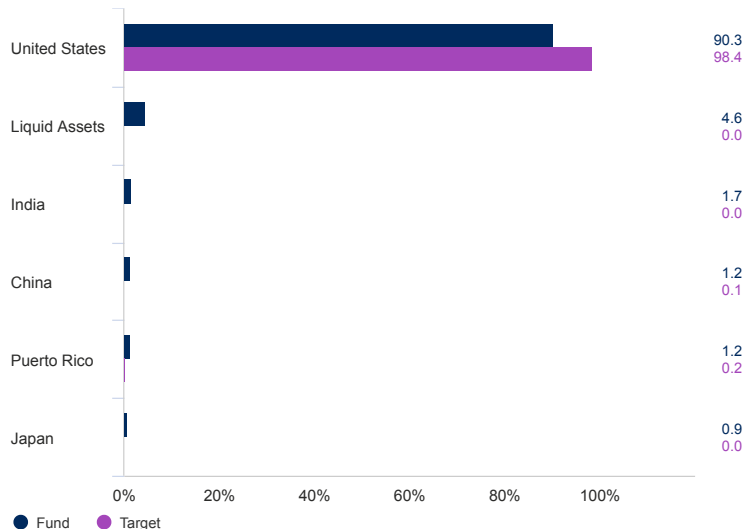

Geographical Breakdown (%)

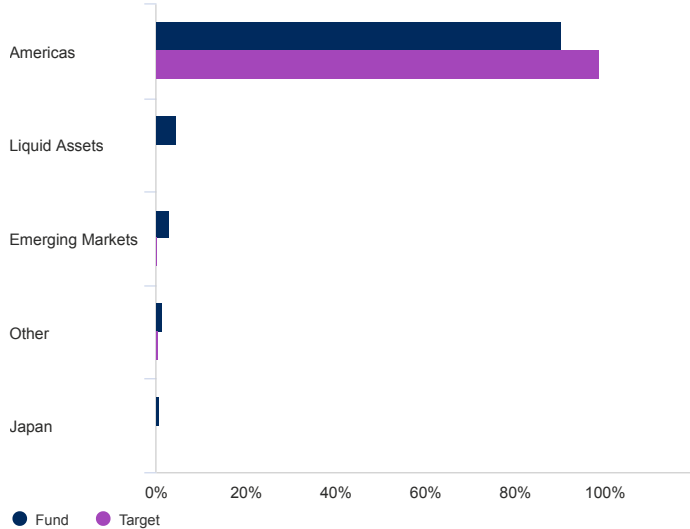
