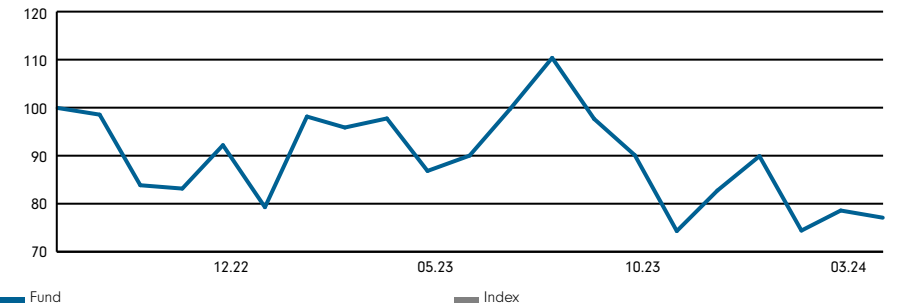

The Index is designed to reflect the performance of a global universe of companies engaged in the production of electric and/or autonomous vehicles and their components, technology, or energy systems or engaged in other initiatives that aim to change the future of transportation (the "Index Theme"). The Index Theme comprises two sub-themes: (a) future transportation technologies, which covers activities such as, but not limited to, manufacturing of electric vehicle, lithium batteries, electric vehicles charging stations or ride sharing apps and (b) future transportation enablers, which covers activities such as, but not limited to, power devices, application processors or electronic circuits semi-conductor company or supporting components and software manufacturing such as sensors, GPS, or autonomous software/electronics. The Index comprises equity securities of the relevant companies.

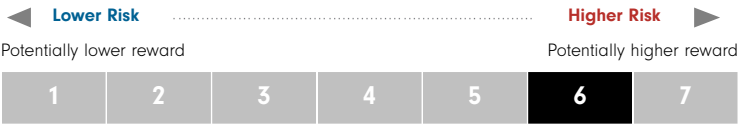

Risk and Reward Profile

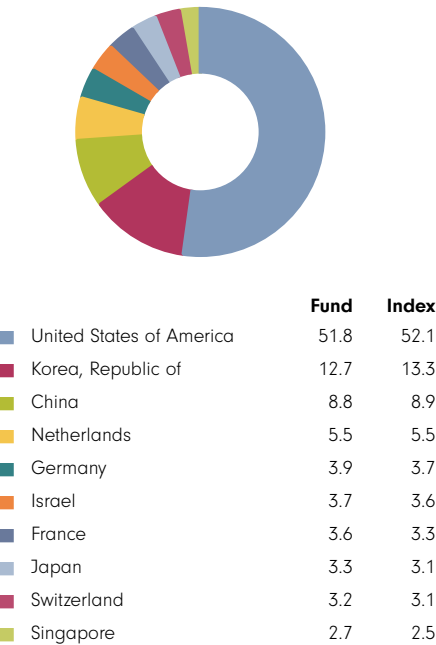

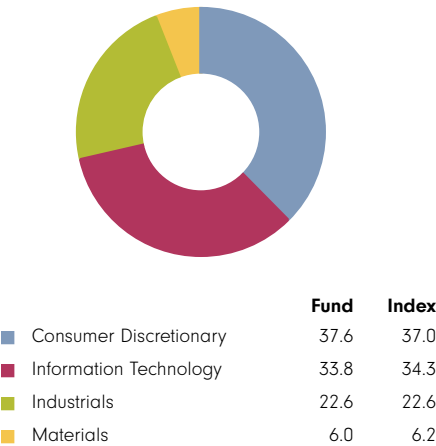
