

### Product features

- At least 70% of the Fund's total assets will be invested in the equity securities of such companies. Up to 30% of the Fund's total assets may be held as cash and cash equivalents, money market securities or invested in debt (including convertible debt) or equity securities issued by companies outside the discretionary consumer sector.
- The Fund may use derivatives (including but not limited to futures, forwards, non-deliverable forwards, swaps and complex options structures) for hedging and efficient portfolio management purposes.
