

# BEA Union Investment China High Yield Income Fund

- BEA Union Investment China High Yield Income Fund (the "Fund") is subject to general investment risk, China market concentration risk, emerging market risk and currency risk.

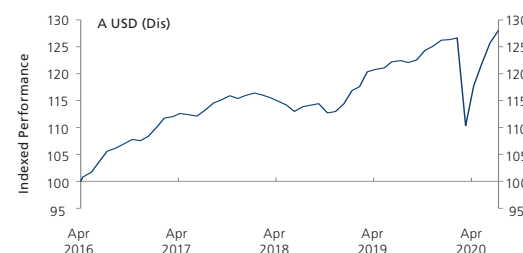
