Sustainability Label

Sustainable investment labels help investors find products that have a specific sustainability goal.

This product does not have a SDR sustainability label as it does not meet the qualifying requirements.

Sustainability Approach

The fund aims to provide income and long-term capital growth over a period of 5 years or more. The fund invests at least 80% of its assets in securities of issuers with high ESG ratings.

The fund invests at least 70% of its assets in equities of companies globally and this could include investment in countries that are considered emerging markets. The fund aims to hold a concentrated portfolio of 30-50 securities.

In determining sustainability characteristics, the Investment Manager takes into account ESG ratings provided by Fidelity or external agencies to invest in companies with sustainability characteristics. High ESG ratings are defined as issuers rated by Fidelity ESG ratings as a B or above, or in the absence of a rating from Fidelity, an MSCI ESG rating of A or above.

The fund aims to have a lower carbon footprint compared to that of the MSCI All Country World Index (the "Index").

Exclusions are applied to screen out investments which may conflict with the sustainability approach of the fund. These include involvement in certain controversial issues or activities (such as controversial weapons), international norms such as human rights. Other more specific exclusions may be applied to the fund. Revenue thresholds and transition criteria may apply.

The fund may invest in securities of issuers with low but improving sustainability characteristics. The fund may obtain exposure to other transferable securities, collective investment schemes, money market instruments, cash and deposits and is also able to use derivatives for efficient portfolio management (but not on any significant basis).

The fund is actively managed. The Investment Manager identifies and selects companies with an attractive, dividend income and/or income growth. The Investment Manager will, when selecting investments for the fund and for the purposes of monitoring risk, consider the MSCI All Country World Index. However, the Investment Manager has a wide degree of freedom relative to the index and may take larger, or smaller, positions in companies, and/or may invest outside the index, to take advantage of investment opportunities. This means the fund's investments and therefore performance may vary significantly from the index.

Sustainability Metrics

The Investment Manager regularly monitors the fund's holdings to verify compliance with the investment policy and exclusions and reviews the following metrics:

(i) The percentage of the fund invested in securities of issuers with high ESG ratings;

(ii) There is no exposure to investments that undertake activities that are excluded completely or at a company revenue threshold in accordance with the fund's investment policy.

In addition, the Investment Manager carries out a quarterly review of the fund to consider its sustainability characteristics.

Funds with sustainability characteristics may perform differently to the market or other funds that invest in similar assets but do not apply sustainability criteria.
