

# Allianz Dynamic Asian High Yield Bond

Allianz Global Investors Fund  
AMg

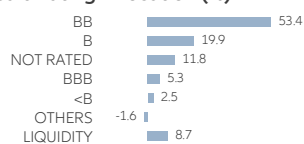

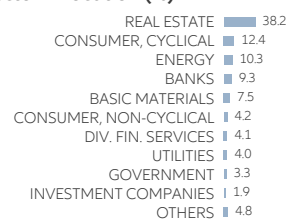

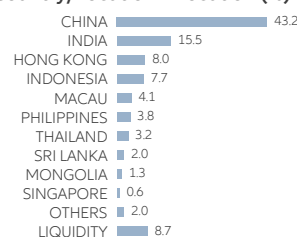
### Credit Rating Allocation (%)



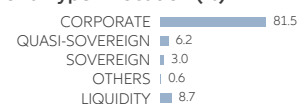
### Sector Allocation (%)
