The fund aims to provide capital growth in excess of the Standard & Poors 500 (Net TR) Lagged index after fees have been deducted over a three to five year period by investing in equities of large-sized US companies.

This fund may use financial derivative instruments as a part of the investment process. Derivatives carry a high degree of risk and should only be considered by sophisticated investors.

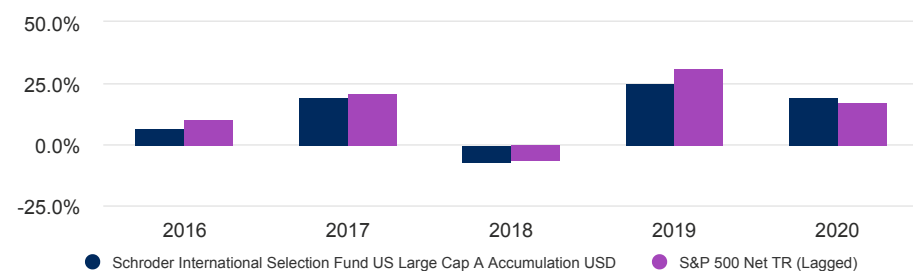

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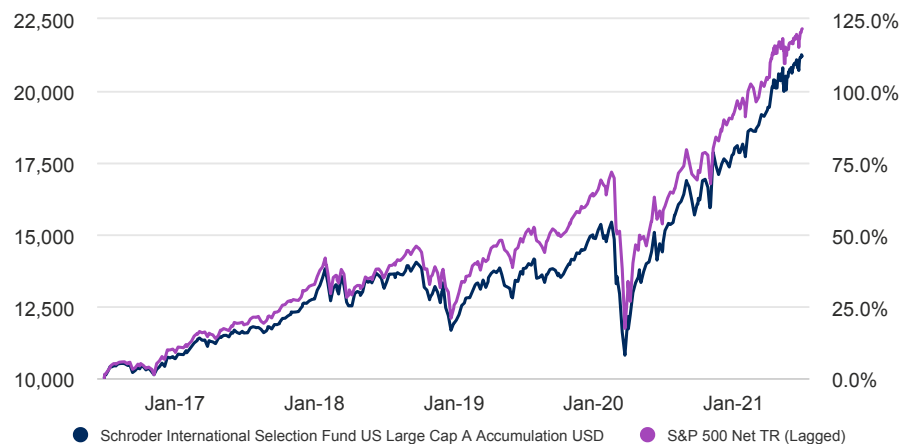

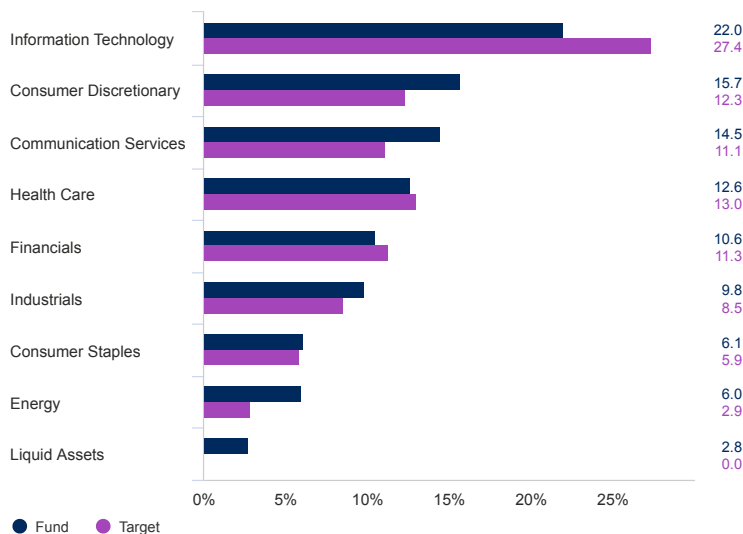

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Benchmark and corporate action information

On 20.08.2001 Schroder ISF US Equity changed its name to Schroder ISF North American Equity. On 15.05.2006, this fund changed its name to Schroder ISF US Large Cap. The Fund's performance should be assessed against its target benchmark, being to exceed the Standard & Poors 500 (Net TR) Lagged index. The Fund's investment universe is expected to overlap materially with the components of the target benchmark. The Investment Manager invests on a discretionary basis and there are no restrictions on the extent to which the Fund's portfolio and performance may deviate from the target benchmark. The Investment Manager will invest in companies or sectors not included in the target benchmark in order to take advantage of specific investment opportunities. The target benchmark has been selected because it is representative of the type of investments in which the Fund is likely to invest, and it is, therefore, an appropriate target in relation to the return that the Fund aims to provide. On 30.11.2011 the S&P 500 Net TR Lagged replaced the S&P 500 (Composite) Lagged. The full track record of previous benchmark has been removed and replaced with the new one.
