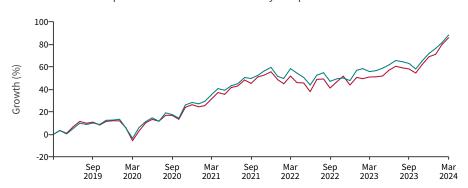
About the fund
