# Objectives and Investment Policy

#### Simplified objective:

The objective of EasyETF ITRAXX EUROPE CROSSOVER is to offer exposure to the European credit market by reproducing the performance, both upwards and downwards, of theMarkit iTraxx<sup>®</sup> Europe Crossover - Bloomberg code: ITRXTX5I Index, (the "Index") less charges for management, operations and structuring costs.

#### Key Fund characteristics:

- The Fund's assets will be composed of financial instruments (shares in French companies from all sectors and/or shares in European companies and fixed-income bond and money-market instruments). It uses either the so-called 'synthetic' replication methodology or a direct replication methodology.

#### Other information:

- Details on assets traded: financial contracts (swaps, etc.) and/or equities. The Fund will be synthetically exposed through financial contracts to changes on the European real estate equity market via the Index.

- Allocation of income: capitalisation.

- Frequency of NAV calculation: calculated daily provided that the markets underlying the Index and the market on which the Fund is listed are open. NAV is calculated during the opening hours of the stock exchange.

The Fund has a risk indicator of 5 because the performance of the European bond market may exhibit high levels of volatility, both upwards and downwards. This may cause sharp, rapid changes in the value of your investments.

Detail of significant risks for the Fund not taken into account in the indicator risk:

<u>Credit risk</u>: This risk is related to the capacity of an issuer to honour its commitments and/or to the risk of the issue of an issuer being downgraded, which could result in a drop in the value of the instruments to which the Fund is exposed, which could result in a drop in the Fund's NAV.

**Liquidity risk**: Market liquidity is particularly demonstrated in the form of a wide price trading range; unitholders bear the risk of loss to the adjustments of the forward financial instruments held by the Fund during illiquid market phases. Consequently, in such situations, the costs related to the adjustments of the instruments held by the Fund in case of subscriptions or redemptions may be particularly significant and may impact the Fund's NAV.

**Counterparty risk**: The Fund will be exposed to counterparty risk arising from the over-the-counter forward financial instruments entered into in order to realise the management objective. Counterparty risk means the losses incurred by the Fund as a result of its investments with a counterparty if the counterparty defaults.

**Capital risk**: The attention of investors is also drawn to the fact that the Fund may not perform in line with their objectives and that any money invested (less entry charges) may not be recovered in full.

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# Charges

The charges and commissions you pay are used to pay the operating costs of the Fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing units; these charges reduce the potential growth of your investments.

This figure may vary from year to year, and it excludes:


- performance fees
